Zachary's Ladder 2004

Color: Brilliant dark ruby

Aroma: Cola, black cherry/ cassis and caramel.

Flavor: Led by blackberry and toasty notes, the 2004 Zachary's Ladder shows a great balance of fruit, oak and integrated tannin. Albeit a "Big" wine at 14.8% alcohol, its rich and creamy texture makes it a very hedonistic and very drinkable wine.
